2. Read verse 3. What is the significance of God’s dwelling place among his people? How does this fulfill God’s covenant promises (Eze 37:26-27; Jn 1:14)? What does God do for his people (4)?
3. How does this happen (5-6a)? What promises does God give to his children (6b-7)? What destiny awaits evil doers (8)?
4. How does the vision of “a new heaven and a new earth” lead us to victorious life in the midst of sufferings?
